# Pizza Hut wings it at new locale in Lorain

**LORAIN** — Residents in Lorain and Sheffield Lake have a new place to get their pizza and chicken wing fix.

Pizza Hut officially opened its newest Lorain location, at 3490 Colorado Ave., at 4:30 p.m. yesterday, according to District Manager Jim Hickman.

"We've been really busy since then," he said.

"I think it's awesome," said General Manager Kim Canter, 41, of Vermilion. "We're going to do great here."

The business offers Pizza Hut's regular menu of pizza, pastas and desserts, but also features Pizza Hut's WingStreet menu for delivery and pickup.

Hickman said the main difference between WingStreet wings and Pizza Hut's normal wings is that the WingStreet wings are fried, while the normal ones are baked.

"The wings are absolutely phenomenal," Hickman said.

The new restaurant replaces the Sheffield Lake location at 4175 Lake Road. According to Hickman, most of the Sheffield Lake employees were transferred to Lorain, and some went to Avon Lake. In addition to those that moved, the new location also created 21 new positions and they are still looking to hire a few more people. He added that anyone interested in employment should apply online at [www.pizzahut.com](http://www.pizzahut.com).

Hickman said a main reason for the move was because the Sheffield Lake building was too old and needed updates for the new equipment. He also pointed out the business is now more centrally located in the delivery area — northeast Lorain and Sheffield Lake.

The business will normally open at 11 a.m., but yesterday's late time was mostly due to getting the computers and other equipment up and running, according to Hickman. The regular business hours will be 11 a.m. to midnight, Sundays through Thursdays, and 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays. The lobby will be closed at dark, but the pickup window will remain open until closing time. The phone number is (440) 288-6000.
